MEDICAL

Application from parents at the beginning of the new academic session, to place their wards in a class / section of their choice shall not be entertained.

Age Certificate :

Birth Certificate from the Corporation, Municipality, Notified area, or a certificate from the office for registration of birth and death. An Affidavit is not acceptable. It is the responsibility of the parents to enter the correct name and date of birth of their child in the Admission Form. It will not be permitted later to make any alterations either in the name or in the date of birth on the plea, that a mistake had been committed at the time of admission. So think and act and declare the correct date of birth only.

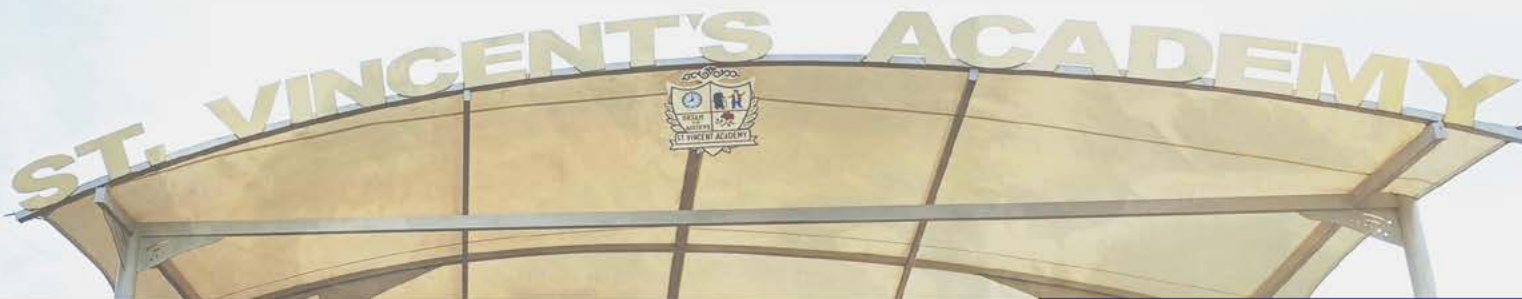
